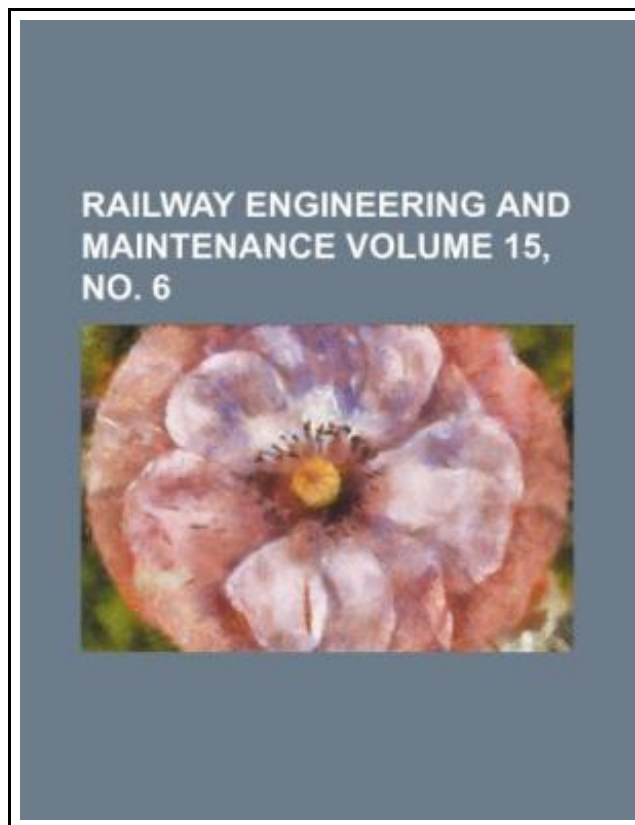

On our line where the bridge department forces are separate from the building department, we have always arranged our bridge work so as to keep at least a moderate force employed steadily during the winter on work which can be done then as well as at any other time, and in that way always have a force available for use in case of emergency or special jobs of any kind.
