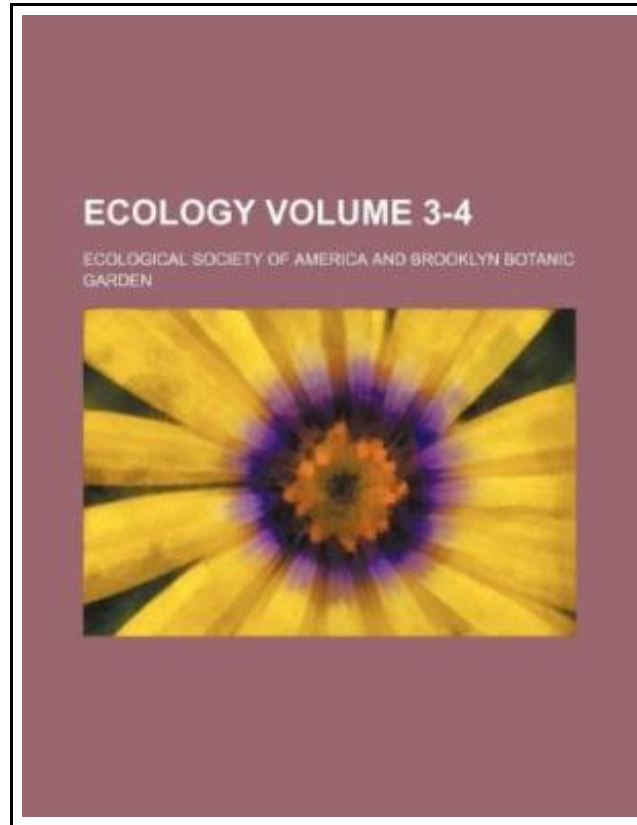

On top of some of the smaller hills, also, where erosion is quite rapid, there are areas of small broken rock much mixed with soil. On the steeper slopes there may be extensive exposures of limestone ledges. In all these rocky areas the soil is scanty and the vegetation poor. Grasses and sedges are nearly absent, and herbs usually grow thinly, though in a few places on the more gentle slopes there is a moderately thick growth. This habitat was not studied to a very great extent, and the following list of plant species is known to be very incomplete: *Amorpha fruticosa*, false indigo. *Argemone intermedia*, white prickly poppy. *Brauneria angustifolia*, narrow-leaved purple cone-flower. *Ceanothus ovatus*, smaller red-root. *Mcgapterium missouriensc*, Missouri primrose. *Pentstemon cobaea*, *Cobaea* beard-tongue. *Pentalostemon tenuifolium*, silky prairie-clover. *Silphium laciniatum*, compass plant. *Symphoricarpos symphoricarpos*, coral berry. *Verbena stricta*, hoary vervain. *Yucca glauca*. bear grass. Aerial community: A number of species of birds in the region capture flying insects. Several species of bats also occur in the region, but I have no specific identifications. Cultivated-field community: *Lampropeltis* sp. King snake I Terrapenc Carolina subsp. Box tortoise I *Geomys bursarius*. Prairie pocket-gopher Abundant *Lepus californicus melanotis*. Great Plains jack-rabbit I *Sylvilagus floridanus mearnsii*. Cottontail 4 Cultivated fields are numerous in the vicinity of Manhattan, particularly in the valleys.
